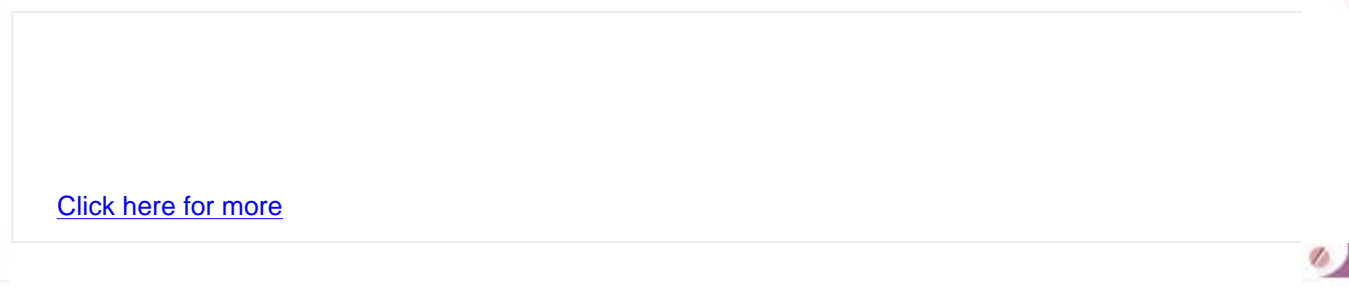

Dr Mehta is associated with the Mehta International Eye Institute, at Colaba, Mumbai. He has been appointed honorary ophthalmic consultant to Maharashtra Police and honorary Ophthalmologist at ONO Eye Hospital, Geneva, Switzerland.

He is the first Indian to be appointed Indian editor of the journal of the European society of cataract surgeons called Eurotimes, the most widely read eye magazine in the world. He is also the first Indian to address the joint meeting of the American and European eye surgeons (Moscow 2005).

Is there any likelihood of getting back my eyesight after retina detachment operation done twice? I was operated in March 2006 by a leading hospital.

Expert Comments : Dear Mr Moorthy, it depends if the retina is attached or if the pressure in the eye was high after surgery. The retina being living nerve tissue responds poorly to surgery. The only way to know what to do is after a complete evaluation.

Is it true that there is no laser procedure for cataract removal?

Expert Comments : Laser procedures for cataract do exist and are widely used in Switzerland and Germany. The laser energy is focussed on a titanium target which vibrates. Also direct Nd:Yag lasers are there for cataract surgery.
